

Number of programmes in foreign languages







RUDN UNIVERSITY OPEN OLYMPIAD FOR FOREIGN CITIZENS (in 2016-2018)






Popular fields of study and specialties in 2018 among Russian Federation citizens – in number of students in any mode of study in bachelor's, specialist's, master's programmes in 2018






