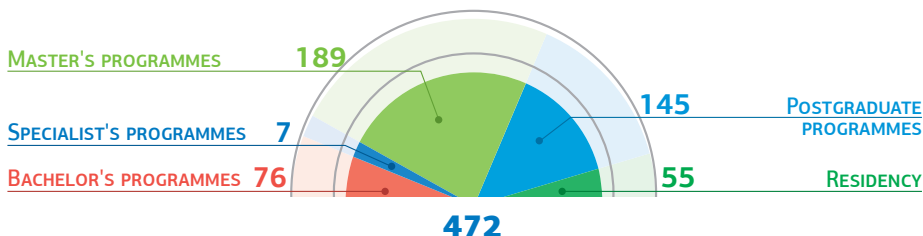

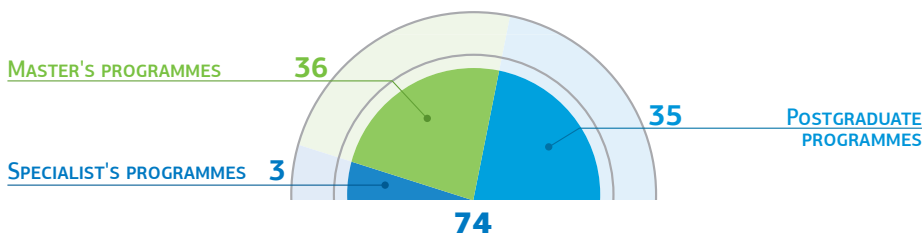

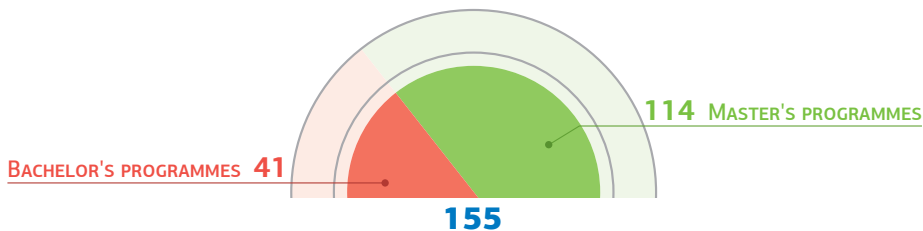
NUMBER OF DEGREE PROGRAMMES (RUDN UNIVERSITY WITHOUT BRANCHES)



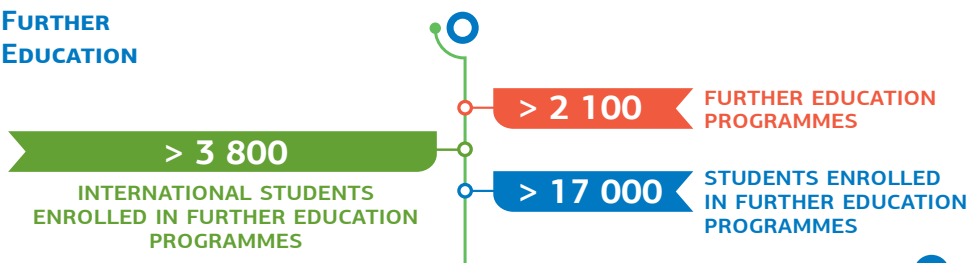
NUMBER OF PROGRAMMES IN FOREIGN LANGUAGES (ENGLISH, SPANISH)

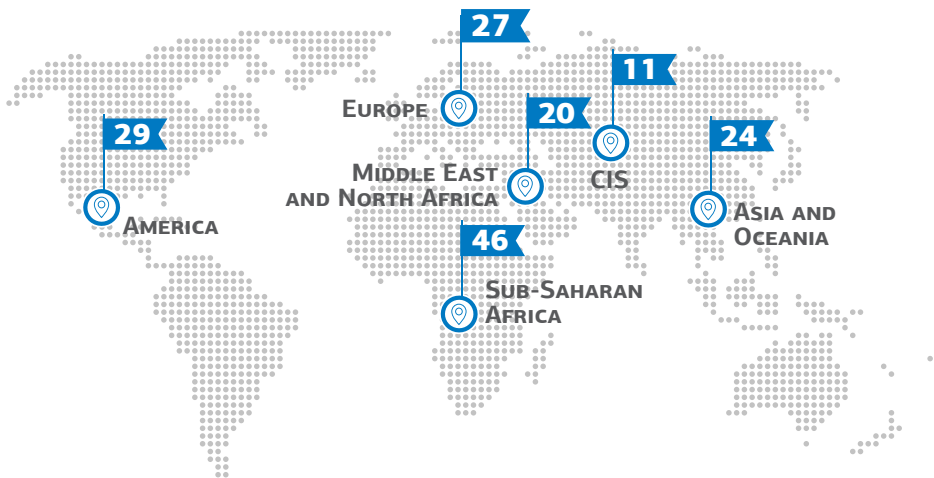

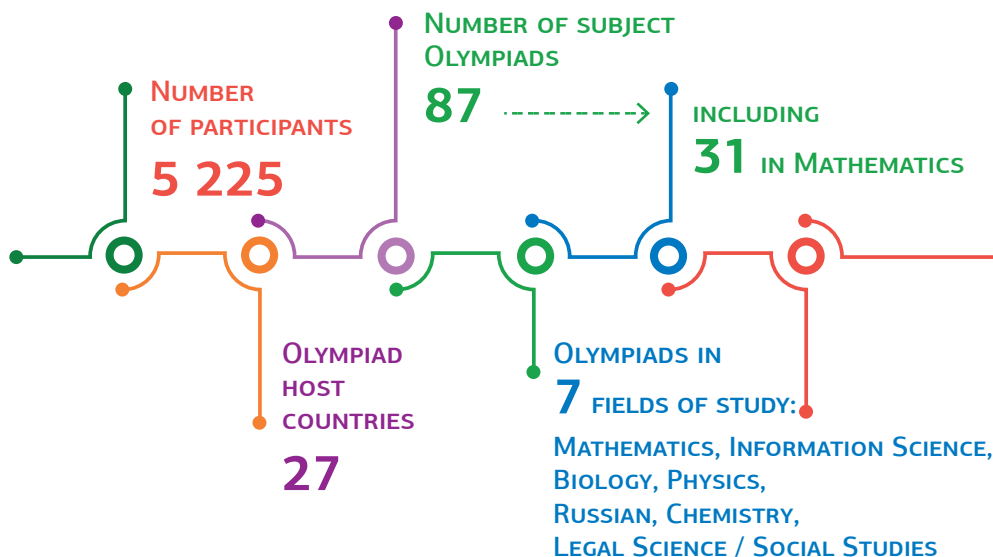

RUDN UNIVERSITY OPEN OLYMPIAD FOR FOREIGN CITIZENS (in 2016-2018)

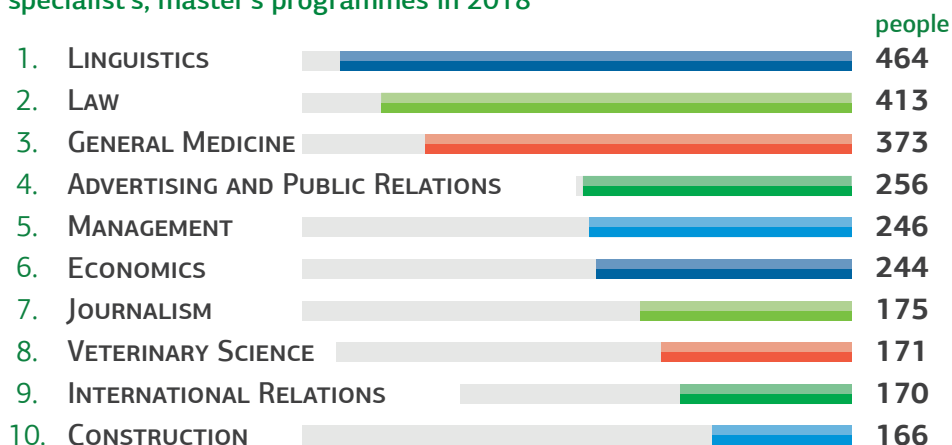

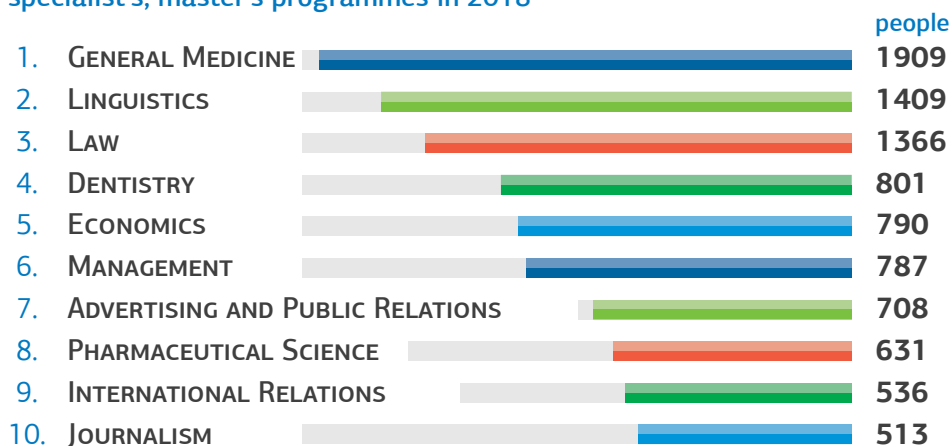

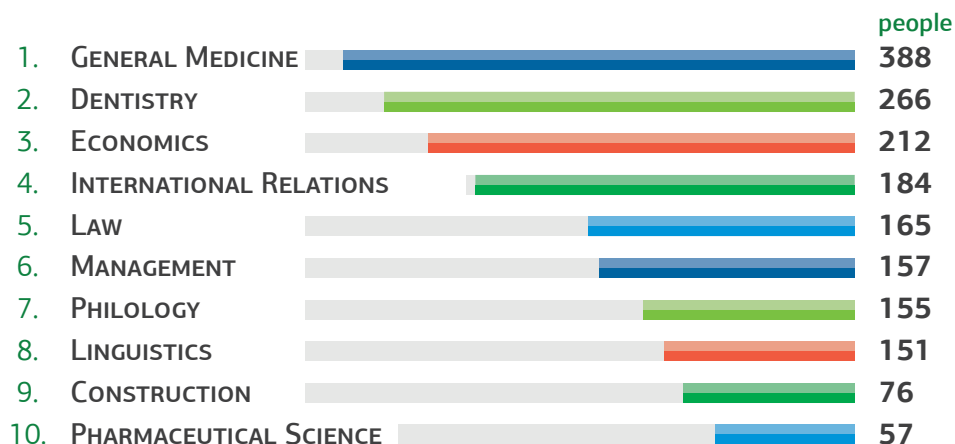


Popular fields of study and specialties in 2018 among Russian Federation

specialist's, master's programmes in 2018

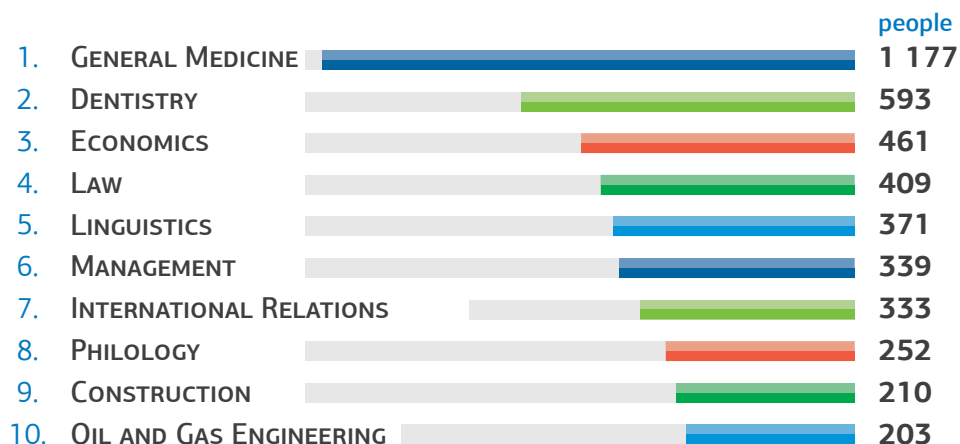

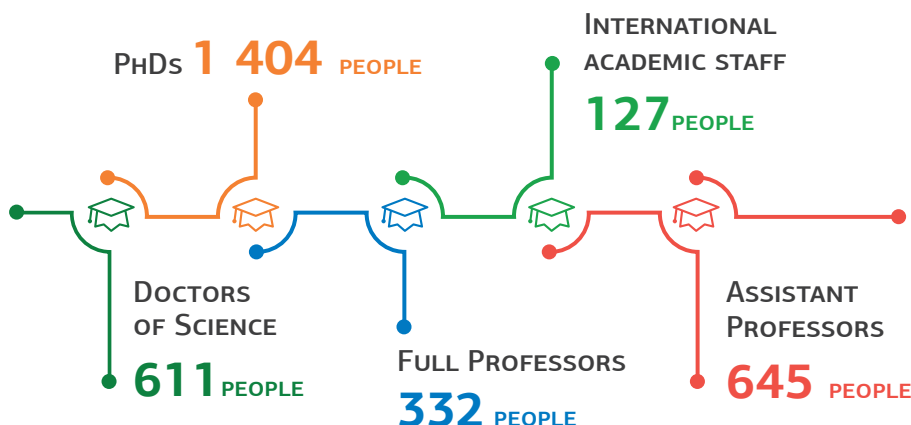

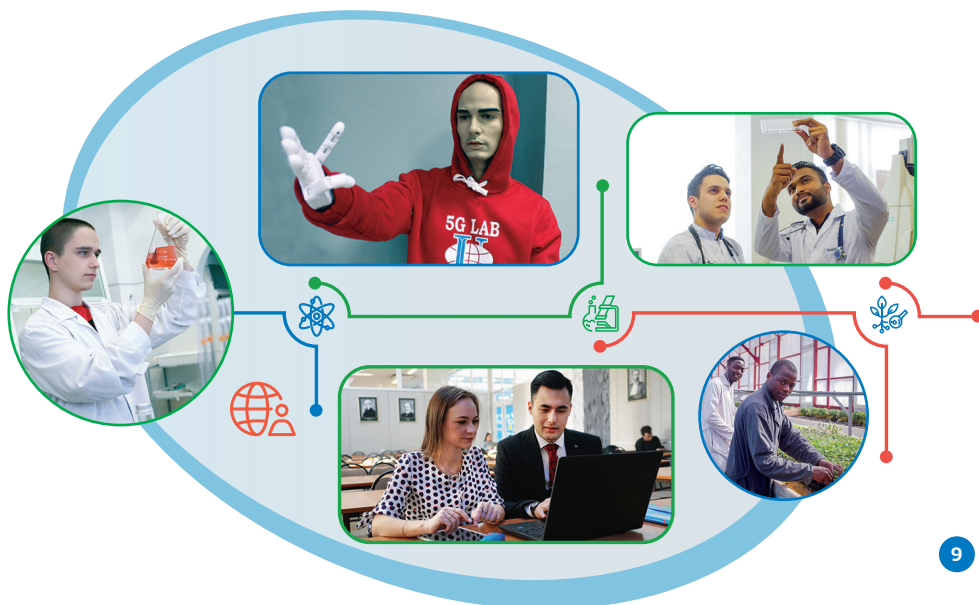

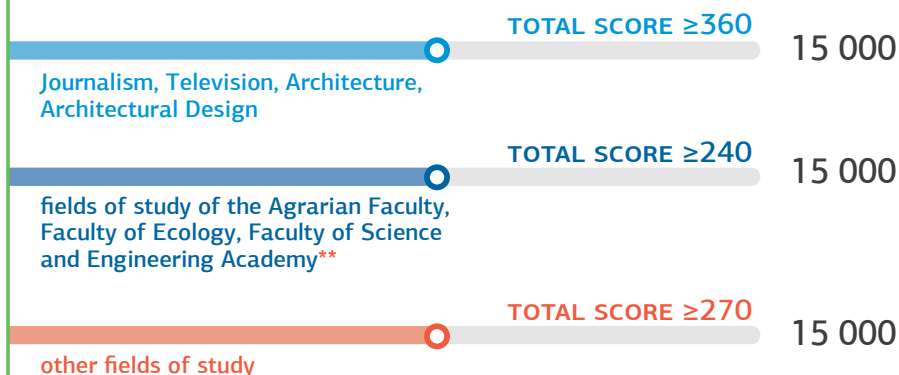

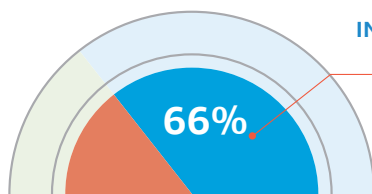
